



Grade: Rate of Destruction



Grade A: Slow rate; < 0.25 ; heavy biofilm deposits w/ low level of destruction; no CAL loss over 5 years; non-smoker; normoglycemic, no diabetes

Grade B: Moderate rate; $0.25-1.0$; destruction commensurate with biofilm deposits; $< 2\text{mm}$ CAL over 5 years; smokes < 10 cigarettes/day; HbA1c $< 7.0\%$

Grade C: Rapid rate; > 1.0 ; destruction exceeds expectations given biofilm; rapid progression and/or early onset disease; ≥ 10 cigarettes/day; HbA1c $> 7.0\%$
